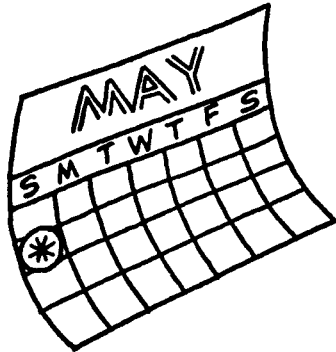


# Mother's Day

1. Mother's Day is the second Sunday in May.



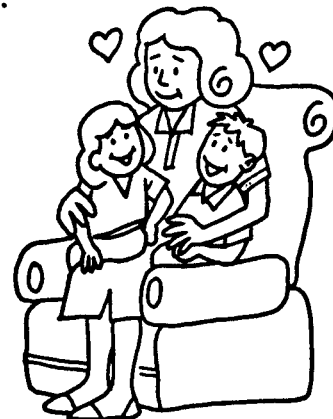
2. On Mother's Day, we say thank you to our mothers.
